How do I sign up for the BattleBlock Theater Steam Beta Test and how will I know if I've been chosen?

To sign up for the BattleBlock Theater Steam Beta Test you first need to create a Steam account. Then **read all the important information** on the Beta Test page before you register using our Beta Test Registration Form. Applying through the registration form does not guarantee that you will be selected.

If you are selected, you will receive an email from The Behemoth to confirm if you are still willing to do Beta Testing. Any updated documents, such as Terms and Conditions or FAQ, may be sent to you at this point. Once you agree to accept the position as Beta Tester, you will be sent a Beta key via email. This key will be sent prior to the start of the Best Testing Period (March 24, 2014 to March 31, 2014), so all Beta Testers will be expected to download the Beta on the first day and complete all the tasks before the end of the Beta Testing Period.

How are Beta Test participants selected from the applicant pool?

Beta Testers are chosen according to a criterion of various factors. Our goal is to have a good variety of people playing the game for the best test compatibility.

Which regions will be able to participate in the Beta Test?

Residents in all regions with Steam will be eligible to participate in the Beta Test. However, this is void where prohibited by law.

Can I tell other people who don't have the Beta about the features in game?

Yes, you can tell people about the game. However, you cannot share video footage or audio from the game and monetize it.

Also, please understand that this version of the game is in a Beta state, so please don't write any official reviews about this until we've actually released the game. This applies during the Beta Period as well as after the Beta Period has finished. These rules apply to all Beta Testers.

What are your goals for this Beta Test?

The primary reason for the BattleBlock Theater Steam Beta Test is for us to test out the game in a real world setting, get some quality feedback about the online game experience and the overall features within the game. Additionally we'll be looking for any bugs that might be uncovered before release.

But! Do not try to break the game! We want people to just play as they normally would.

Beta Testers are critical in ensuring that the game runs smoothly and is fun for everyone on release, so they have a big impact on our development process.

How much am I going to get paid?

Participation in the Beta is voluntary and will not be remunerated in any monetary way. (So don't hate us for not paying anyone!)

How long will the Beta Test last?

The Beta Test will start on March 24, 2014. The Beta will be available for at least a week.

All selected Beta Testers will need to download the Beta on the first date of release and complete all Beta Testing Tasks within the schedule (which will be emailed to selected Beta Testers), including the daily gameplay survey.

What game content will be available in the beta?

The Beta will include access to all areas of the game, but keep in mind that this is a Beta and not all areas may be complete. Beta Testers will also have access to the Level Editor and the Community Theater for user created levels.

Will the progress I make during the Beta Test carry over when the game launches? Yes, that's the plan!

If I don't have an active Steam account now, can I still register and activate one if I'm selected? Steam accounts are required to enter and we will need your Steam ID when you register. Accounts are free to make on Steam! Please go Here.
